Dear Friends,

Greetings from Littlemore where we are always delighted to welcome pilgrims and visitors to Newman's College. The purposes of their visits are manifold. Some come for Newman studies and seminars, some have an historical interest, some come on a pilgrimage to give thanks for the spiritual support and inspiration they receive on their journey of faith through the example and prayers of Blessed John Henry Newman and to ask for his guidance, while others find The College to be a place of peace and tranquillity in the middle of a busy world. One of our Friends wrote the following account after a two weeks' stay:

THE NEWMAN EXPERIENCE

My wife and I have been visiting Newman's College in Littlemore for some five years on a regular basis. Newman has been an integral part of my spiritual life for almost thirty years; reading about his life, work and legacy was instrumental in my own conversion to Catholicism in 1997. My wife, who is a 'cradle Catholic', has found her spiritual life enriched by Newman

in a way unimaginable to her before encountering him. Now living abroad, where Newman's spirituality is less known and palpable than in England, we see it as a great blessing and a huge privilege to be able to spend time in the place, where Newman made the key decision of his life.



Newman's College is a place of retirement and prayer, where we feel we can continue our own spiritual search in a similar way to which Newman did in the 1840's. We would recommend that everyone should give the 'Newman Experience' a try.

'BIRTHDAY PARTY' AND OTHER EVENTS IN THE FUTURE

On Wednesday, 21st February 2018, we will be celebrating John Henry Newman's birthday with an evening event of words and music. We are delighted that Fr Guy Nicholls of the Birmingham Oratory has agreed to give a talk on *Cardinal Newman's View of Beauty*. Father Guy is presently preparing to publish a book on Cardinal Newman's aesthetics entitled *Unearthly Beauty*.

The talk will be followed by a performance from a local String Quartet of some movements from two of Newman's favourite composers, Mozart and Beethoven.


